The Cain Sczepanski Foundation in Special Education was created in 2011. Cain Sczepanski lived for 24 years with Down syndrome and congenital heart defects. Cain died in March of 2011 of a heart attack. For 18 years, Cain was guided by dedicated LISD teachers and paraprofessional staff at Central, Donald, and Highland Village Elementary Schools, Briarhill Middle School and Marcus High School. He was especially proud to be a Marcus High School graduate. The Sunday before Cain died, he said, as he always did when passing by Marcus, “Marc, me school.” The Cain Sczepanski Foundation in Special Education created the Award of Excellence to recognize the classroom excellence of LISD Special Education teachers or paraprofessionals. 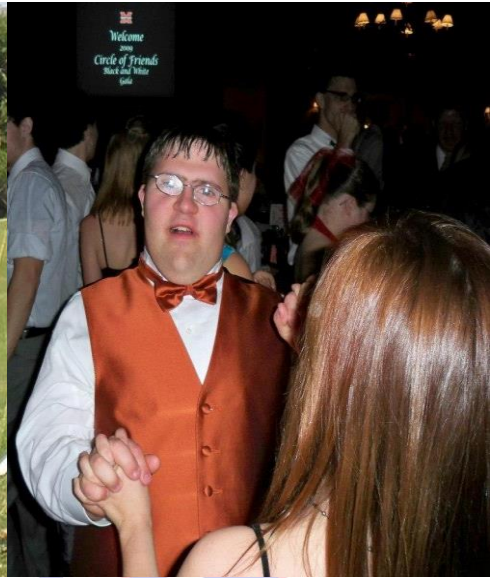
